■ ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN OMA WORKFORCE COMMUNITY
■ PRIORITIES ALIGN WITH OMA WORKFORCE ROADMAP/KPIs
■ COMPLETED SUPPLY/DEMAND ANALYSIS

For your sector partnership to be endorsed by OMA, your organization must submit an endorsement application, linked below. Here are the questions to address each criteria, for your reference:

- Describe your sector partnership's leadership structure. Please include the roster for your executive committee or leadership team and describe how this group ensures the ISP's activities are aligned with manufacturers' needs. If needed, you may upload your organization charter, bylaws, etc., in the field below.
- Is your sector partnership focused on manufacturing only? If no, please explain.
- Please provide a list of manufacturing member companies.
- Please list the counties your sector partnership covers.
- Do any of these counties overlap with another active sector partnership? If so, please explain. To review other ISP regions, please refer to the OMA Sector Partnership Directory.
- Describe how your sector partnership collaborates with education providers and workforce development partners in your region.
- Describe the responsibilities / job description of the intermediary. Is the intermediary an employee of the ISP or another organization?
- How does your sector partnership intermediary remain neutral?
- State your top strategies to address Workforce Development issues for the year.
- Describe your sector partnership's involvement with the OMA Workforce Community. Be sure to include community, grant implementation teams, and the learning community.
- Describe how your sector partnership priorities align with the OMA Workforce Roadmap.
- Describe your members' greatest hiring needs. How are your education partners equipped to meet those needs?
